NEWS FROM THE VIA ALGARVIANA PROJECT

1st EDITION OF THE VIA

The Mount of Furnazinhas, with about 70 residents, received the first edition of the Via Algarviana Festival on the weekend of 15 and 16 October. The event received from participants and visitors an estimated number of 100 people, also involving about 40 habitants, in the organization of handicrafts workshops (basketry, fresh cheese, rope, chairs and rents), the exhibition of the works and social dinner.

The Saturday dinner was done by some inhabitants and joined about 50 people, as consisted on a traditional dish, the fry (a Fritada). This first edition of the Via Algarviana Festival still drew attention of the media getting a visit from the regional press and of an British journalist who went purposely to the site.
